

HOW TO MAKE A THERAPY REFERRAL FOR APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS (ABA)

All children in Oregon are eligible for ABA Services regardless of payer

REQUIREMENTS FOR ABA THERAPY ARE:

- A diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder (ASD).
- Documentation of the less intensive treatments that have been tried or a statement that they have been considered and not deemed able to produce acceptable outcomes.
- Copy of the ASD diagnostic evaluation.
- Order for ABA treatment without specifying hours or intensity.

All items above should be sent to the ABA therapy provider who will then get authorization through the insurer.

IF NO DIAGNOSIS OF AUTISM HAS BEEN MADE YOU MUST FIRST:

Refer your patient to a doctor or psychologist experienced in diagnosis or treatment of autism for an evaluation for autism spectrum disorder, such as :
